What is a CLS?

A child life specialist is a healthcare provider who works with your child during medical challenges or hospitalization to ensure their life remains as normal as possible. They may help ease discomfort during hospital stays as well as teach your child coping skills through play, preparation, education and self-expression.

What education do you need?

To become a child life specialist you need extensive training and education. To begin you need a 4 year undergraduate degree. These could include a bachelor's degree in child life, or a bachelor's degree in human development or psychology. If you choose a degree in human development or psychology, normally you would minor in Child life. During these programs you will extensively learn about Communication skills, child development, coping techniques, and basic medical jargon. Some stop there, and others continue to get their masters. The masters program will give you more hands on learning. In addition You will need an internship or fellowship of 600 hours, this Must be under direct supervision of a certified CLS. You will Also need to take and pass the association of child life Professionals exam.



What will you be making yearly?

The U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics keeps track of average annual salaries. According to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, the average annual salary of a child life specialist was \$60,470 in 2020.



What does a Child life specialist do in a children's hospital setting.

- Child life specialists provide patient- and family-centered care in a children's hospital. They focus on easing any discomfort your child has before, during and after medical care. They work with you and your family to prepare and educate you for your time at the hospital.

Child life specialists provide useful coping strategies to lessen the stress of being in the hospital. These strategies may include play and self-expression activities. They provide emotional support for your family. They also encourage your child's development while they're dealing with health issues.




